### PRASANTHI NILAYAM SEVA – APRIL, 2019

Dear Sai Brothers /Sisters, Sairam.

- NOTE: 1. All sevadal should bring their ID Cards and Scarfs. They must wear white dress during Prasanthi Nilayam seva which is compulsory. Jean pants and T-shirts are not allowed.
  - 2. Youth to be motivated to participate in Prasanthi Seva.
  - 3. Drivers to be identified
  - 4. To nominate batch incharges & group leaders, to be sent one day before registration and they must stay until the seva is complete.
  - 5. Do not send sick and aged for seva.

By His Divine Grace, we have successfully completed Prashanthi Nilayam Seva in Nov, 2018 during Bhagawan's 93<sup>rd</sup> Birthday Celebrations. This was possible due to devotion, dedication, and involvement of all of you. Let us pray Bhagawan that we complete Jan. 2019 Seva and Sports day Celebrations in the same manner.

Sevadal of AP&TS have to carry out Security and Utility Services at Prasanthi Nilayam in April 2019. The DPs and Dist. Sevadal Coordinators are requested to send young, energetic, and experienced sevadal (Gents & Mahilas) as per the allotment indicated in the statement. District Youth coordinators shall identify 40% youth in the allotted quota and provide their names and details to the DPs in advance. The Regional Youth coordinators and State Youth coordinator are requested to coordinate mobilization of youth. The DYCs / RYCs and SYCs shall ensure that the youth are motivated, trained and briefed before they attend PN Seva. I request all of you to put in more efforts during the 3 batches of April 2019 Seva which includes Aradhana Mahostayam.

The District wise deployment of Gents and Mahila Sevadal for the 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> batches and special batches in April 2019 is enclosed.

Few districts are sending more sevadal in 3rd batch, but they are not meeting their allotment figure in the  $\mathbf{1}^{st}$  and  $\mathbf{2}^{nd}$  batches. The DPs are requested to ensure to concentrate on  $\mathbf{1}^{st}$  and  $\mathbf{2}^{nd}$  batches also as the allotment of sevadal in these two batches is minimum.

Please send this circular to the DYC, DSC and other District coordinators, gents / mahila and to all Samithi conveners without fail.

DPs are requested to depute educated Graduate/Post Graduate and/or Professionally qualified youth within age group of 20 to 35 years with a height of 5' 7" to 5' 9", and well built with proportionate belly and shoulder and of normal to fair complexion for Core Group selection, duly coordinating with DYC's against 40% youth quota.

It is mandatory for the DPs to tour each and every Samithi and Bhajan Mandali along with District Service coordinators and District Youth Coordinators, motivate active workers and devotees to mobilize the required sevadal as per the allotment and criteria given. They are requested to contact sevadal in person to motivate them to attend PN Seva. DPs are requested to divide the district into zonesand allot each zone to one of the District Coordinators so as to coordinate, mobilization and motivation of Sevadal along with Samithi and Bhajan Mandali conveners. As already informed, all sevadal must be trained and briefed about Prasanthi Nilayam Seva by conducting training camps before coming to seva. Details of the Training Programmes (Venue and Date) may be informed to State Sevadal Coordinator (PN Seva). The number of Sevadal attending each camp may also be informed. The nominated Batch in-charge and Group Leaders also shall attend the Training / Briefing camps in the District.

Please note that first time comers for PN Seva may be sent only after Briefing and training at District level. It is the responsibility of DPs and DSCs to ensure that sevadal who are chronic BP, diabetic, heart patients, old and physically disabled, mentally retarded persons, patients suffering from Fits shall not be deputed for PN Seva. In spite of repeated advices, sending such persons causes anxiety and disturbance during seva. Please note the following:

1) We must ensure that office bearers and Samithi Conveners and Samithi Coordinators attend Prasanthi Nilayam Service at least once in 3 years. The DPs shall prepare a roaster of all District, Samithi and Bhajan Mandali office bearers immediately and ensure that all office bearers attend PN Seva. A copy of the roaster duly prepared may be sent to me so as to monitor about their attendance for PN Seva. All ASMs shall attend Prasanthi Nilayam Seva not less than once every year. This shall be monitored by DPs and DSCs.

- We must ensure to improve the quality of PN Seva in order not to inconvenience the devotees coming for the Divine Darshan and to avoid comments from Ashram Authorities.
- 2) The DPs or Dist. Service Coordinators shall be present at Prasanthi Nilayam and coordinate the registration, duties allotment for the three batches.
- 3) DPs are requested to inform in advance the names of nominated Batch-in-charges and Group Leaders. They shall report for duties on the allotted dates and perform Seva for full period and leave Prashanthi Nilayam only after completion of duty period. It is observed that many sevadal are reporting late and arriving on the date of taking charge or after 2 or 3 days at their convenience. Due to these delays, deployment in sectors is effected and proper deployment is not taking place. DPs shall ensure that all sevadal arrive on the date of reporting. The nominated Batch in-charges shall know the sevadal sent from their Districts. The Batch in-charge shall not be a new member. Similarly, the nominated Group Leaders shall have knowledge of the sector proposed for them and must have rendered seva in that sector earlier.
- 4) All sevadal must be above 18 years age. School and Junior college students below 18 years of age shall not be sent. If reported, they will be sent back.
- 5) Identity cards for sevadal shall not be issued at Prashanthi Nilayam. Identity cards must be issued only at the Districts and sent.
- 6) Tractor drivers and other drivers shall be sent with their original licenses.

Sevadal preferably Youth (Gents & Mahilas) should attend the Special Batch during Aradhana Mahostavam as per the enclosed District-wise allocation from 21<sup>st</sup> to 25<sup>th</sup> April 2019 ( 5 days).

Further, the Youth batch looking after loading, transportation and unloading are requested to attend from 23<sup>rd</sup> to 25<sup>th</sup> April 2019. Sri A.Ramprasad & Smt Aparna (Prakasam) 9290038866, State Youth Co-ordinators are requested to motivate the youth and meet the requirement during April Seva and Aradhana Mahostavam.

Also, Gents Sevadal preferably Youth and Mahila Sevadal as per the District-wise allocation given shall attend Prashanthi Nilayam Seva special batch from 21st to 25<sup>th</sup> April 2019 (5 days).

For Aaradhana Mahotsavam, all DPs, District Coordinators (at least 2 from each District) including youth Coordinator must compulsorily attend the seva for 24<sup>th</sup> April. They must report on 23<sup>rd</sup> April without fail.

State Youth Co-ordinators (Gents & Mahilas) must submit the number of youth sevadal coming for this special batch seva before 10<sup>th</sup> April 2019 to the State President.

Sevadal should bring their Identity Cards, and Scarfs. White dress for gents sevadal is compulsory.

A detailed Sector wise Gents Sevadal deployment will be separately informed by Sri V.Subba Rao, State Service Coordinator(PN Seva), and Smt K.Kiran, State Coordinator PN Seva (Mahilas) will look after all works on Gents and Mahilas side respectively.
